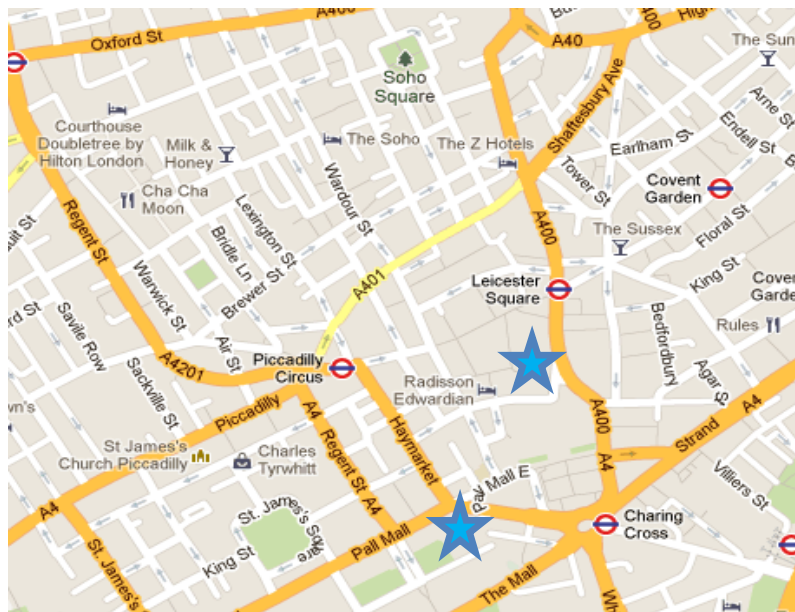

All shows are subject to availability, which may be limited during half term, holidays, peak seasons and weekends. Some restrictions may apply during such periods.





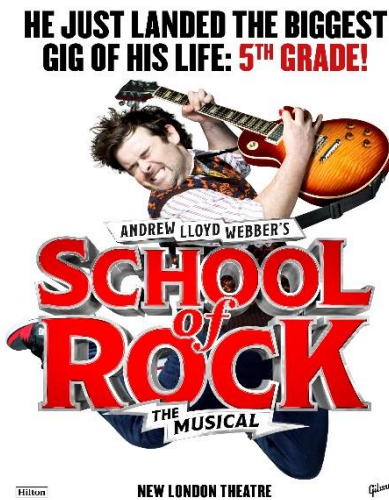


Kinky Boots


